CONSPIRACY THEORIES

[A proposed plot that rejects the standard explanation for an event and instead credits a covert group or organization with carrying out a secret plot. They're goal is sinister and they have something to gain from what they're doing while not having people's best interests at heart]

> Conspiracy theories are speculative and they're not supported by actual evidence.

Many conspiracies are a deliberate attempt to misinform the public for political gain and leverage.

People tend to believe theories that reaffirm their beliefs more easily.
